Melodic Minor - a, b, d, g, c
Viola/Cello: 3 octaves
Major - C, D, E flat, G, A flat, A
Melodic Minor - a, c, d, e, g
Bass: 2 octaves
Major - E, F, G, A, B flat, B
Melodic Minor - e, f, g, a, b

Ensemble Information

Instrumentation may be altered based on audition results

ORCHESTRAS:

String students will be selected for the Symphony Orchestra (full orchestra) and Chamber Orchestra (a small ensemble which may or may not include some winds) based on their audition score. The maximum number of strings for the **Symphony** is as follows (final decision of eligibility made by Audition Chairperson):

First Violin – 22, Second Violin – 22, Viola – 16, Cello – 14 & Bass – 8

The maximum number of strings for the **Chamber Orchestra** is as follows (final decision of eligibility made by the Audition Chairperson):

First Violin – 10, Second Violin – 10, Viola – 8, Cello – 6 & Bass – 3

Students auditioning for the Preparatory Orchestra will be selected based on their audition score. The maximum number of strings for the **Preparatory Orchestra** is as follows (final decision of eligibility made by Audition Chairperson):

First Violin – 22, Second Violin – 22, Viola – 16, Cello – 14 & Bass – 8

Students are eligible to play only one SRO audition per academic year. 9th and 10th graders must choose to play either the Preparatory Orchestra audition OR the Chamber/Symphony Orchestra audition. 11th and 12th graders are only eligible to play the Chamber/Symphony Orchestra audition.

ALL-STATE ELIGIBILITY:

Only students who are selected for the Senior Regional Symphony Orchestra and fulfill their commitment at the 2018 SRO event will be eligible to audition for All-Virginia Orchestra.

DIRECTORS:

- I. ***All high school Orchestra and Band Directors who have students auditioning MUST be present and participate in the adjudication process on September 30th.*** Student eligibility depends on your required attendance.
- II. Violation of any School rules, VMEA rules, or VBODA rules will result in disqualification.
- III. All registration forms and fees must be submitted on time! All items will be due by **Friday September 14th, 2018.** This includes all paperwork and pre-registration.
- IV. Senior Regional Orchestra EVENT information will be available to the directors at the auditions.

Sr. Regional & All-State Bowings:
 Ascending: 2 slurred, 2 separate marcle
 Descending: 4 slurred

Martele: literally "hammered," a type of bow stroke where notes are played with an even weight from one end of the bow to the other with a lightly hammered attack.
