#### THURSDAY, APRIL 11

---

- Morning** Load bus and depart Cox High School for **Pennsylvania Dutch Country**
- Upon arrival to the **Amish Country** group will travel to the **Kitchen Kettle** to meet your Custom Music Tours Escort. Grab a bite to eat (not included in the package price). Spend some time shopping for souvenirs at the **Kitchen Kettle** where you will visit the more than 30 shops and experience the daily life of the Amish community.
- Afternoon** Group tour **The Amish Farm and House, Weavertown One Room Schoolhouse and Discover Lancaster County History Museum**. Start your visit learning about Amish history and heritage on the guided house tour and then wander through the Amish countryside on a picturesque bus tour. Be ready to take a lot of photos! After the guided tour you can spend time on the 15-acre farm where you can feed and pet the farm animals, ride an Amish scooter, walk across the covered bridge and explore the Amish-built schoolhouse.
- Board your coach and transfer to your hotel for check in.

More than a dozen of our nation's most important historical attractions can be found here-including the Liberty Bell in its new glass-enclosed pavilion and Independence Hall. Tour **Independence Hall, Congress Hall, The Liberty Bell Pavilion and Carpenter's Hall**
- Afternoon** After the tour your group will transfer to **The Bourse at Independence Mall** to eat lunch at one of the many eateries. Lunch is not a part of the package plan.
- 2:00 PM** After lunch your group will transfer to the **Kimmel Center** for **The Philadelphia Orchestra**
- Evening** Group will drive past **the Philadelphia Museum of Fine Arts** where you will take enough time to follow the footsteps that made Rocky Balboa famous in the "Rocky" movies. Make sure to take a group photo on the stairs in front of the Rocky Statue.
